Boiler and Plant	Two 200 kW ETA Hack wood chip boilers with ETA Buffer tanks.
Fuel	The boilers use wood chip for fuel and produce in excess of 1324 MWh.
Chip Storage	The chip is ordered and delivered by PBE Ltd.
Grant/ Funding	The project was funded by PBESCO Ltd. We retained ownership of the heating system . We service, maintain and supply the fuel.
Savings/ Investment	PBESCO Ltd retained ownership so there was no installation costs to Pembrokeshire County Council.
Commissioned	The two boilers were commissioned in October 2009.



Project Overview

Haverfordwest leisure centre needed a reliable heat source which was environmentally friendly and cost effective. The centre comprises of 3 large swimming pools, a fitness suite with sauna, a café, climbing wall, tennis courts, and multiple rooms for fitness classes and other activities.

Pembrokeshire County Council thought the best option was for PBESCO Ltd to install and retain ownership of the boilers. This meant that PBESCO Ltd receive the RHI payments, but that Pembrokeshire County Council receive peace of mind knowing we maintain and service the boilers. The council pay the fuel costs, which is supplied by PBE Ltd.
